IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-four of chapter sixty-five of the Revised Statutes, relating to allowances to widows.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section twenty-four of chapter sixty-

- 2 five of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended so
- 3 as to read as follows:

'SECT. 24. A widow shall have her reasonable

- 5 sustenance out of the estate of her husband for
- 6 ninety days after his death; and may remain in the
- 7 house of her husband during said ninety days with-
- 8 out being chargeable with rent therefor.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
