STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for copying Muster-Out Rolls.

Resolved, That the Governor and Council be and

- 2 are hereby authorized to contract for the copying
- 3 of the muster-out rolls of the Maine troops who
- 4 served in the war of the rebellion, at a sum not
- 5 exceeding eight hundred dollars, and said amount
- 6 to be paid from the military appropriation.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The muster-out rolls of the Maine troops in the rebellion are fast wearing out, and before long it will be with great difficulty that the same can be read. A very small portion of the rolls have been copied, and it is deemed to be of the highest importance that the remainder should be copied without any further delay.
