STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT in relation to Paupers in Unincorporated
Places.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Whenever persons who have no legal settlement
2 within the State, are found in unincorporated places,
3 and needing immediate relief, and are brought into
4 any adjoining town obliged by law to care for and
5 furnish relief to such persons, and relief is so fur-
6 nished, the State shall reimburse said town for such
7 relief so furnished in the same manner and under
8 the same restrictions as provided in section twenty-
9 nine, chapter twenty-four of the Revised Statutes
10 as amended, although the overseers of the poor of

11 said town have no permit in writing from the Gov-
12 ernor and Council to remove the same into their
13 town.
