## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 68 of Chapter 18 of the Revised Statutes, relating to Ways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 68 of Chapter 18 of the Re-

- 2 vised Statutes is hereby amended so as to read as
- 3 follows:

'Sect. 68. When a way or street is raised or

- 5 lowered by a surveyor or person authorized, to the
- 6 injury of an owner of land adjoining, he may,
- 7 within a year, apply in writing to the municipal
- 8 officers, and they shall view such way or street
- 9 and assess the damages, if any have been occa-
- 10 sioned thereby, to be paid by the town, and any

- 11 person aggrieved by said assessment, may, in addi-
- 12 tion to any other remedy now provided by law,
- 13 have them determined, on complaint to the supreme
- 14 judicial court in the manner prescribed in Section
- 15 18 of this chapter as amended by Section 5 of
- 16 Chapter 359 of the laws of 1885.'
  - Sect. 2. This act shall apply to all claims aris-
  - 2 ing under said Section 68 since March 6, 1885,
  - 3 and proceedings thereon.
