STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT for the protection of Patrons of Agricultural Fairs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The receipts of the Maine State 2 Agricultural Society, the Eastern Maine State Fair, 3 and all county agricultural societies, are hereby 4 exempted from attachment, trustee process and 5 seizure on execution until current expenses of the 6 fair, purses and premiums awarded by the society 7 are paid, provided that the same are paid, within 8 three months from the close of the fair.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
