STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize cities and towns to accept and
manage lands and buildings and property for the
use of the people of cities and towns as a Public
Library or Art Gallery.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Any city or town in the State may accept by vote
2 of the people thereof any land, or land and build-
3 ing thereon, to be used as a public library or art
4 gallery or both combined; also any books, charts
5 or maps, and any funds the income of which to be
6 used to purchase books, maps or charts, and
7 keep the same in order.
