STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize cities and towns to accept and manage lands and buildings and property for the use of the people of cities and towns as a Public Library or Art Gallery.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Any city or town in the State may accept by vote

- 2 of the people thereof any land, or land and build-
- 3 ing thereon, to be used as a public library or art
- 4 gallery or both combined; also any books, charts
- 5 or maps, and any funds the income of which to be
- 6 used to purchase books, maps or charts, and
- 7 keep the same in order.
