STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Sec. 72, of Chap. 4 of the Revised Statutes, relating to making false statements to the officers preparing and revising Lists of Voters or in charge of Ballot Boxes at Elections.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 72, of Chap. 4 of the Revised Statutes, 2 is hereby amended so as to read as follows;

'At any meeting for the election of any officer, 4 where a list of voters is necessary, whoever wilful-5 ly votes before the presiding officer has had oppor-6 tunity to find his name on said list, or knowing that 7 it is not on it, or wilfully gives any false answer or 8 statement to the municipal officers of towns, cities

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9 or plantations when they shall be previously pre-10 paring such list, or presiding at such meeting, in 11 order that his name or the name of any other per-12 son may be entered on such list, or his vote or that 13 of another be received; or casts more than one vote 14 at one balloting; or is disorderly at such meeting, 15 forfeits for each offence, not exceeding one hun-16 dred, nor less than ten dollars.
