STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND BIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT fixing the Salary of the Adjutant General.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. From and after January one, 1887, 2 the salary of the Adjutant General shall be twelve 3 hundred dollars per annum, payable quarterly, in-4 stead of the sum now provided by law.

SECT. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent 2 with this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-2 approved.
