# STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter three hundred and fiftyone of the laws of eighteen hundred and eightyfive relating to Agricultural Institutions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section eleven of chapter fifty-eight 2 of the Revised Statutes as amended by chapter 3 three hundred and fifty-one of said laws is hereby 4 amended by adding to said section the words, 'and 5 the West Oxford Society shall receive as much as 6 is raised by it, not exceeding two hundred dollars,' 7 so that said section as amended shall read as 8 follows:

#### HOUSE-No. 246.

'SECT. 11. The treasurer of an incorporated ag-10 rigultural or horticultural society, on application 11 made prior to the first Wednesday of each December 12 shall receive from the State treasury a sum equal to 13 that raised by such society during the year preceding, 14 but not exceeding one cent to each inhabitant of 15 the county where it is located, according to the 16 last preceding national census, nor more than four 17 hundred dollars to one county. If there is more 18 than one such society in any county, and the sums 19 so applied for exceed the limits aforesaid, it shall 20 be paid to each in proportion to the amount 21 expended by it, as hereinafter provided. But the 22 Penobscot and Aroostook Union Agricultural So-23 ciety may annually receive as much as is raised by 24 it, not exceeding one hundred dollars, without re-25 gard to population; and the Waldo and Penobscot 26 Agricultural Society as much as is raised by it, not 27 exceeding one hundred and thirty dollars; and 28 the same shall be deducted from the sums allowed 29 to said counties, in proportion to the number of 30 inhabitants of each county within the limits of such 31 society; and the Ossipee Valley Union Agricul-32 tural Society shall receive as much as is raised by 33 it, not exceeding two hundred dollars; and the

34 West Oxford Society shall receive as much as is 35 raised by it, not exceeding two hundred dollars.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
