STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize Henry W. Tucker to dredge and navigate by steam Medowmak Pond in Knox County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Henry W. Tucker, his associates 2 and assigns are hereby authorized to clean chan-3 nels, dredge bars and remove stones in Medow-4 mak pond in the county of Knox, and are hereby 5 vested with the exclusive right against all persons, 6 of employing and navigating every kind of boat, 7 or water craft, propelled by steam, for carrying

- 8 passengers on said Medowmak pond for the term
- $9\,$ of ten years from the passage of this act.
