STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the erection and maintenance
of piers and booms in the Kennebec river at Mad-
ison.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. B. P. J. Weston, his associates,
2 successors and assigns are hereby authorized and
3 empowered to locate, build and maintain in the
4 Kennebec river at Madison, in the county of Som-
5 erset, on the easterly shore of said river, on land
6 of said Weston, near his steam saw-mill and the

7 easterly shore of said river in said Somerset
8 county, piers and booms for sorting out logs and
9 lumber coming down said river for use and manu-
10 facture in his said mill and for holding the same.
11 But said works shall be so constructed as not to
12 impede the use or navigation of said river, and not
13 to occasion any unreasonable delay or obstruction
14 in the driving of any other logs and lumber.

SECT. 2. Said parties by aid of such piers and
2 booms, may separate or sort out such logs and lum-
3 ber, coming down said river, as are destined and
4 intended for use and manufacture in their said mill,
5 and may also hold such logs and lumber, so sorted
6 out for their use and manufacture as aforesaid.

SECT. 3. Said parties may take such lands as
2 may be necessary for the erection and maintenance
3 of said piers and booms and connecting the same
4 with the river shore, and may, with their agents,
5 servants and teams, pass and repass over said
6 shores, and to and from the same over the land of
7 other persons for the purposes aforesaid and for
8 managing said piers and booms making compensa-
9 tion therefor as is provided in the case of damages
10 for lands taken in laying out highways.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
