STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the New England Telephone
and Telegraph Company to place its wires under
the surface of streets in the cities of Portland and
Lewiston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The New England Telephone and
2 Telegraph Company shall have the right to place its
3 wires and cables under the surface of streets in the
4 cities of Portland and Lewiston, under the super-
5 vision of the municipal officers, and for that pur-

6 pose may, when authorized by the board of alder-
7 men of said cities, construct and maintain its
8 cables, wires, conduits and man-holes in any pub-
9 lic way or street designated in such grant of
10 authority.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and
2 after its approval.
