STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of Appropriations for Academies and other institutions of learning.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. All appropriations heretofore or 2 hereafter made by the legislature for academies, 3 seminaries or educational institutions other than 4 free high schools shall be paid out of the common 5 school funds.

SECT. 2. All acts or resolves or parts thereof 2 inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.
