STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT in addition to Chapters 27, 17, 133 and
135, Revised Statutes, and all amendments thereto,
so that they shall apply to liquors in the original
package.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

All of the provisions of chapter twenty-seven,
2 chapter seventeen, section twenty-three of chapter
3 one hundred and thirty-three, and section one of
4 chapter one hundred and thirty-five, of the Revised
5 Statutes, with all amendments thereof, and all addi-
6 tions thereto, so far as they relate to intoxicating

7 liquors, are hereby made to apply to all intoxicating
8 liquor imported in the original package.
