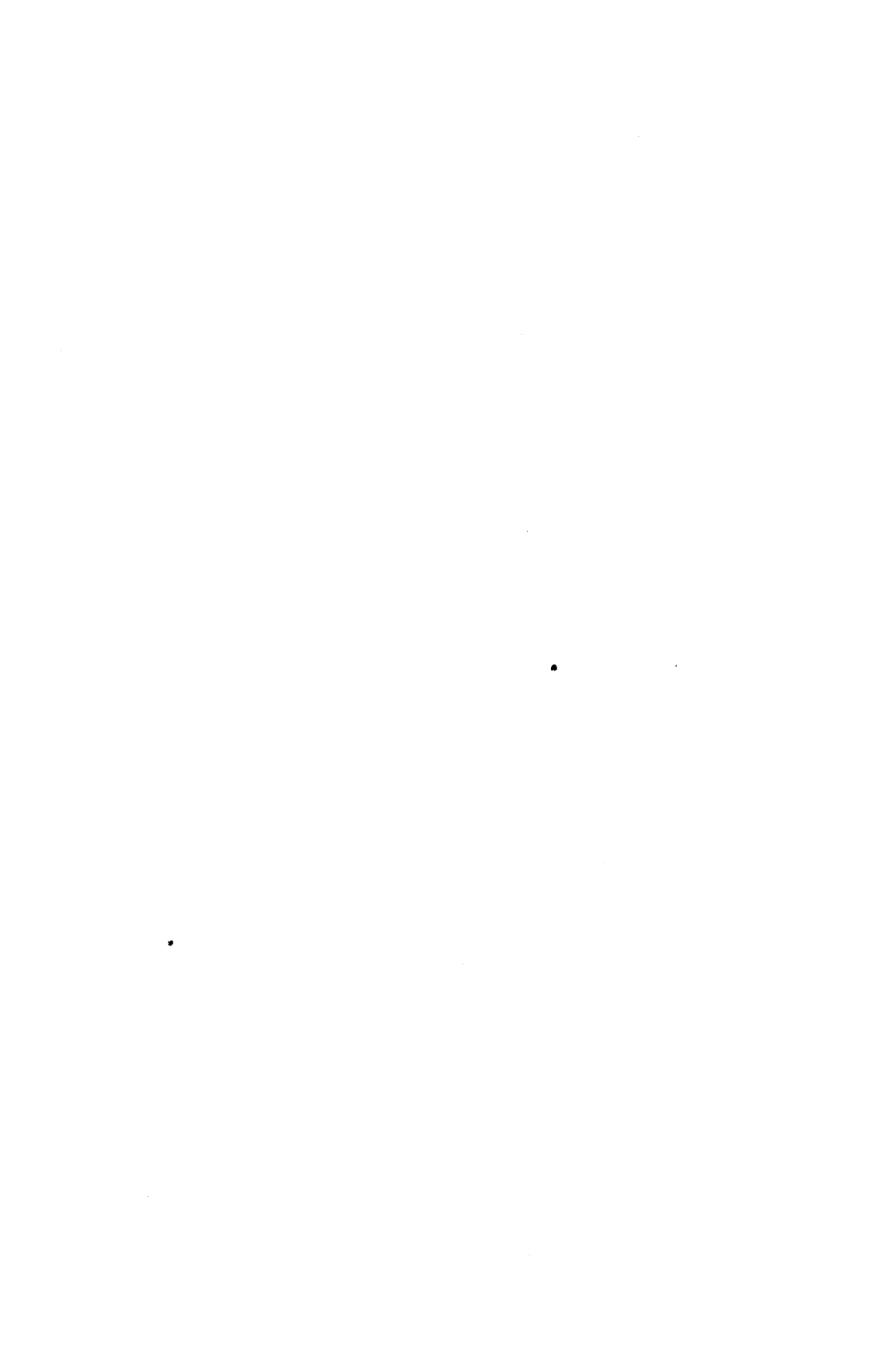
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of the clerk
of courts in Kennebec county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The clerk of courts of Kennebec
2 county shall be allowed attendance the same as pro-
3 vided for clerks in other counties by chapter three
4 hundred and sixty-five of the Public Laws of eigh-
5 teen hundred and eighty-five.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
