STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter three hundred and nine of the public laws of 1889 making the compensation of Sheriff in Kennebec County equal to that of the other counties, Cumberland excepted.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter three hun-

- 2 dred nine of the public laws of 1889 is hereby
- 3 amended by striking out the words "and Kenne-
- 4 bec counties" in the last clause of said section and
- 5 substituting the word 'county' in place of "coun-
- 6 ties," so that said section shall read as follows:

'Section 1. For each day's attendance by the 8 sheriff on the supreme judicial or either of the 9 superior courts three dollars to be paid from the 10 county treasury.'

This amendment shall not apply to Cumberland 12 county.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
