STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter five hundred and fourteen of the Private and Special Laws of 1889, entitled "An Act to set off part of Drew Plantation and annex the same to Reed Plantation."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one, chapter five hundred and fourteen of the Private and Special Laws of 1889 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

‘Said part of said Drew plantation annexed as
6 above to said Reed plantation is hereby annexed to
7 and made a part of the county of Aroostook.’

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
