STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT for the protection of Pickerel and Bass in Pleasant Pond in Turner.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall take, catch, kill, fish for, 2 or destroy any pickerel or bass in Pleasant pond or its 3 tributaries or outlet, in the town of Turner, County of 4 Androscoggin, from October 1st to June 1st for the period 5 of four years.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions 2 of this act shall forfeit and pay the sum of ten dollars for 3 the offence, and one dollar for each and every such fish so 4 taken, caught, killed or destroyed; to be recovered by 5 complaint before any municipal court, trial justice in said

6 county, one-half to the complainant, and one-half to the7 county where proceedings are commenced.
