STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to prevent the courts of this State from being deprived of jurisdiction of actions against Foreign Accident or Casualty Insurance Companies, and also to prevent limiting the time for commencing actions against such companies to a period of less than two years from the time the cause of action accrues.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

No conditions, stipulations, or agreements, shall deprive 2 the courts of this State of jurisdiction of actions against 3 foreign accident or casualty insurance companies or asso-4 ciations, nor limit the time for commencing actions against 5 such companies or associations to a period of less than 6 two years from the time when the cause of action accrues.
