STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT relating to Highway Ditches and Drains.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The municipal officers of a town may, at

- 2 the expense of the town, construct ditches and drains to
- 3 carry water away from any highway or road therein, and
- 4 over or through any lands of persons or corporations
- 5 when they deem it necessary for public convenience or
- 6 for the proper care of such highway or road, provided
- 7 that no such ditch or drain shall pass under nor within
- 8 twenty feet of any dwelling house without the consent of
- 9 the owner thereof. Such ditches or drains shall be under

- 10 the control of said municipal officers and wilful inter-
- 11 ference therewith shall be punished as is provided by
- 12 statute for obstruction in a travelled road.
 - SECT. 2. Before land is so taken notice shall be given
- 2 and damages assessed and paid therefor as is provided for
- 3 the location of town ways.
