
AN ACT authorizing the Bangor Boom Company to erect a pier in Penobscot river.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Bangor Boom Company is hereby

- 2 authorized to erect and maintain within its limits on the
- 3 westerly side of Penobscot river, a pier nearly opposite
- 4 the northerly line of Daniel Webster's farm, and to be
- 5 within three hundred feet from the westerly bank of the
- 6 river; said pier to be located, to be of such size and pro-
- 7 portions, and to be constructed as shall be determined
- 8 by Joab W. Palmer and William Conners, of Bangor.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
