STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT relative to Fishing in the Tributaries of Lermond and Alford Ponds in the County of Knox.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from

- 2 fishing in any manner for fish of any kind in all of the
- 3 tributaries leading into or tributary to Lermond's and
- 4 Alford's Ponds in the county of Knox for the term of six
- 5 years.
 - SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this
- 2 act shall be punished by a fine of five dollars for each
- 3 offence to be recovered by complaint, one-half to the use
- 4 of the prosecutor and one-half to the use of the county of
- 5 Knox.
