IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACΓ in relation to the Collection of Taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section. 1. Section one hundred and eighty-two of
- 2 chapter six of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended
- 3 by prefixing thereto the following words to wit:
 - 'The collector of taxes of any town and,' so that said
- 5 section when thus amended shall read as follows:
 - 'Section 182. The collector of taxes of any town and
- 7 the treasurer of any town who is also a collector, may
- 8 issue his warrant to the sheriff of any county or his dep-
- 9 uty or to a constable of his town directing him to distrain

- 10 the person or property of any person delinquent in pay-
- 11 ing his taxes after the expiration of the time fixed for
- 12 payment by vote of the town which warrant shall be of
- 13 the same tenor as that prescribed to be issued by munici-
- 14 pal officers or assessors to collectors with the appropriate
- 15 changes returnable to the collector or treasurer issuing
- 16 the same in thirty, sixty or ninety days.'
