STATEMENT OF FACTS, TO ACCOMPANY HOUSE DOCUMENT NO. 56.

Booth Brothers and Hurricane Isle Granite Company were the contractors for the granite used in the construction of the addition to the State House. The plans and specifications required in the construction of the chimneys 579.'2" cubic feet of cut granite. The amount of cut granite actually turnished by the contractor, under the direction of the architects to construct such chimneys as were necessary to the proper completion of the chimneys as exceeded the amount called for by the plans and specification by 599.'6" cubic feet, for which the contractors, Booth Brothers and Hurricane Isle Granite Company should be paid at the contract price per cubic foot for the granite used in the chimneys, viz.: \$1.95 per cubic foot, with interest at 4 per cent., in all \$1262.54.
