STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the city of Old Town.

Resolved, That there be paid by the treasurer of State. 2 out of the school funds of the current year, to the city of 3 Old Town, the sum of three hundred and forty-three dollars 4 and fifty-two cents, it being a balance equitably due said city 5 as its proportion of the school funds for the year eighteen 6 hundred and ninety-one. . .

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The municipal officers of the city of Old Town failed to make the fiscal school returns required by law for the year 1891, on or before the first day of July. In accordance with the statute in such cases provided, by reason of such failure said city received as its share of the State school funds for that year, a sum less, by the amount named in the accompanying resolve, than it would otherwise have received.
