STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The undersigned, municipal officers of the city of Biddeford, respectfully represent that, owing to an oversight, the fiscal school returns of said city for the year 1891 failed to reach the office of the State Superintendent of Schools within the time prescribed by law; and that in consequence of such failure, said city received on account of school fund and mill tax, \$1,121.85 less than would have otherwise been received for the school year 1891-2. They, therefore, respectfully petition for such legislation as may be necessary to reimburse said city for the loss thus sustained.
