## STATE OF MAINE.

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section One of Chapter One Hundred and Ninety-Five of the Special Laws of the year 1887.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and 2 ninety-five of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen 3 hundred and eighty-seven, is hereby amended by adding 4 at the end of said section the following words: 'or com-5 plaint may be made before said court and a warrant issued 6 thereon when authorized by the city solicitor, and said 7 court is empowered to enforce payment of said fines and 8 costs of prosecution by imprisonment in the county jail9 not exceeding thirty days.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
