STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT To enable the City of Calais to maintain Free Bridges across the St. Croix River.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The city of Calais is hereby authorized to 2 lay out and construct a highway across the St. Croix 3 river from some point at or near the end of the Ferry 4 Point toll bridge in said Calais to the boundary line 5 between the State of Maine and the Province of New 6 Brunswick and for that purpose to buy or build a bridge 7 and maintain the same. Said city is also authorized to

8 lay out highways and build bridges at such points across9 said river as it may deem proper above said Ferry Point10 bridge.

SECT. 2. The use of said bridges for street cars, gas 2 and water pipes, electric wires and for similar purposes 3 shall be subject to such conditions as said city of Calais may 4 impose, but no person shall be required to pay toll for travel-5 ing on or over said bridges.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
