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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

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AN ACT to amend section thirty-five of chapter fourteen of  
the Revised Statutes relating to Vaccination.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows.*

Section thirty-five of chapter fourteen of the Revised  
2 Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words  
3 “The mayor and aldermen of any city, and the select-  
4 men of any town or plantation,” in the first and second  
5 lines and substituting therefor the following: ‘The board  
6 of health of each city, village, town and plantation.’  
7 So that said section as amended shall read as follows :

‘Section 35. The board of health of each city, village,  
9 town and plantation shall annually on the first day of  
10 March, or oftener if they deem it prudent, provide for  
11 the free vaccination with the cow pox, of all the inhabit-  
12 ants over two years of age within their respective local-  
13 ities, to be done under the care of skilled practicing  
14 physicians, and under such circumstances and restrictions  
15 as said authorities adopt therefor.’
