## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to the "School Lots" so called of the several plantations and unorganized townships of the State.

Resolved, That the land agent be directed to cause to be

- 2 located the "school lot" or lots so called in each of the
- 3 plantations or unorganized townships of the State that are
- 4 ever likely to be organized, where at present there is no
- 5 record of location, and where said school lots were reserved
- 6 in the conveyance of the land of the several townships,
- 7 and to prepare a complete record of the location of all
- 8 such reserved lots of the State.
