### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to correct the Taxation of the Plantation of Lexington, Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The plantation of Lexington shall be here-

- 2 after exempt from the payment of State and county taxes
- 3 except so far as other townships containing less than two
- 4 hundred inhabitants are taxed.
  - SECT. 2. All State and county taxes on said plantation
- 2 heretofore assessed for the years 1891 and 1892 and
- 3 remaining unpaid are hereby abated.

- SECT. 3. All moneys apportioned to the plantation of
- 2 Lexington during the years 1891 and 1892 on account of
- 3 school and mill tax funds are hereby withheld and the
- 4 treasurer of State is hereby authorized to cancel the same
- 5 on his books.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
