AN ACT additional to Chapter forty-eight of the Revised Statutes, relating to changing the location of Corporations.

 $B_{<}$ it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Any corporation organized under sections sixteen and

- 2 seventeen, of chapter forty-eight, of the Revised Statutes,
- 3 at a legal meeting of its stockholders, may by a vote
- 4 representing a majority of the stock issued, change its
- 5 location from one county to another in this State, and
- 6 the corporation shall file, by its clerk or other officer, in
- 7 the registry of deeds in each of said counties, within
- 8 twenty days after such change of location, the certificate
- 9 required by section eleven of chapter forty-six of the

- 10 Revised Statutes, as amended by section two of chapter
- 11 two hundred sixty-three of the Public Laws of eighteen
- 12 hundred eighty-nine.
