RESOLVE on the petition of George A. Smart and others for aid to repair bridge in South Bancroft over the Mattawamkeag River.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the

- 2 sum of five hundred dollars, to be expended under the
- 3 direction of the county commissioners of the County of
- 4 Aroostook, in repairing the bridge across the Mattawam-
- 5 keag river in South Bancroft.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The bridge over the Mattawamkeag river in Bancroft was built by the State in 1850. It is what is called a latice work, is 125 feet long, resting on two piers, is a covered bridge eighteen feet road way, and twelve feet in the clear, one of the piers is settling at one end and in its present condition canting the bridge. Also the piers are too near the ends of the bridge to get the strength of the bridge, and if not repaired soon will go to ruin, the inhabitants of Bancroft with a valuation of \$46,000 do not feel able to make the necessary repairs without aid from the State.

The estimated amount required for the repairs, is one thousand dollars.
