## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section four of Chapter one hundred of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one, relating to the creation of a Forest Commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section four of chapter one hundred of
- 2 the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one is
- 3 hereby amended by striking out the words 'when they
- 4 deem it necessary,' in the second and third lines thereof,
- 5 so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:
  - 'Section 4. County commissioners of each county in
- 7 which there are unorganized places shall annually appoint
- 8 one or more fire wardens as they deem necessary not
- 9 exceeding ten, for all such unorganized places in any county.'
  - SECT. 2. This shall take effect when approved.
