STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to prevent limiting the time within which notice of accident or injury, or death, shall be given to accident or casualty insurance companies, to a period of less than sixty days.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

No conditions, stipulations, or agreements contained in 2 any application for insurance in any foreign or domestic 3 casualty or accident insurance company, or contained in 4 any policy issued by any such company, or in any way 5 made by any such company, limiting the time within 6 which notice of the accident or injury, or death, shall be 7 given to such company, to a period of less than sixty

8 days after the happening of the accident or injury, or
9 death, shall be valid. Said notice may be given to the
10 company insuring, at any time within sixty days after the
11 happening of the accident or injury, or death, and shall
12 be valid and binding on the company.
