## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED

AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to set off a portion of the town of Camden and annex the same to the town of Rockport.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The following tract of land is hereby set
- 2 off from the town of Camden and annexed to the town of
- 3 Rockport: Beginning at the sea or Penobscot bay on
- 4 the original northerly line of the Daniel Barrett farm,
- 5 thence north forty-five degrees west one hundred and
- 6 thirty rods or thereabouts to the easterly line of the J.
- 7 W. Ogier farm; thence north forty-four degrees east by
- 8 said line thirty rods to an angle in the fence; thence
- 9 north fifty-two degrees east about thirty rods to the north-
- 10 west corner of the Bay Cemetery; thence southeasterly

- 11 by the northerly line of said cemetery to the sea, or
- 12 Penobscot bay; thence southerly by the sea to the place
- 13 of beginning.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
