IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to fix the salary of the Register of Deeds for Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The register of deeds for Penobscot county

- 2 shall receive an annual salary of fifteen hundred dollars,
- 3 and an additional allowance of one thousand dollars per
- 4 year for clerk hire; said salary to be paid from the county
- 5 treasury and to be instead of the fees now provided by
- 6 law, which fees shall be paid into the county treasury for
- 7 the use of said county.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect April first, A. D. 2 1893.
