STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT in addition to Chapter fifty-one of the Revised Statutes in relation to Railroads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The county commissioners in awarding damages for land

- 2 or other property taken by any railroad company shall
- 3 have the power, on the application of such railroad com-
- 4 pany, to prescribe such terms and conditions, in all
- 5 respects, for the use of the land or property taken, by
- 6 the owners thereof, and the railroad company respectively,
- 7 as will secure the best accommodation of the owners, and
- 8 the proper and convenient use of the same by such rail-
- 9 road company. They shall in their award set forth all

- 10 such terms and conditions so imposed by them. In case
- 11 of appeal by either party, the only question in issue shall
- 12 be the amount or measure of damages on the terms and
- 13 conditions imposed by the commissioners.
