STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to regulate the Duties of Recording Officers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No town, city, county or State officer whose

- 2 duty it is to record conveyances of any kind, assignments,
- 3 certificates or other documents or papers whatsoever, shall
- 4 draft or aid in drafting any conveyance, assignment, certi-
- 5 ficate or other document or paper which he is by law
- 6 required to record, in full or in part; under a penalty of
- 7 not exceeding one hundred dollars to be recovered by any
- 8 complainant by action of debt for his benefit or by indict-
- 9 ment for the benefit of the county.
- SECT. 2. All statutes inconsistent with this act are
- 2 hereby repealed.
