## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT relating to embezzlement of property the subject of larceny.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Wheever embezzles, or fraudulently converts to his own

- 2 use, or secretes with intent to embezzle or fraudulently
- 3 convert to his own use, money, goods, or property de-
- 4 livered to him, or any part thereof, whichmay be the
- 5 subject of larceny, shall be deemed guilty of larceny.
