## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section 6 of Chapter 298 of the Public Laws of 1889, relating to Hawkers and Peddlers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section six of chapter 298 of the Public Laws of 1889 is

- 2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "service" in
- 3 the third line of said section the words 'and any Ameri-
- 4 can citizen who is blind' so that said section as amended
- 5 shall read as follows, viz:

'Section 6. Any soldier or sailor disabled in the war

- 7 for the suppression of the rebellion, or by sickness or
- 8 disability contracted therein or since his discharge from
- 9 service, and any American citizen who is blind, shall be
- 10 exempt from paying the license fees required by this
- 11 chapter.'
