IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section fourteen of Chapter fifteen of the Revised Statutes, relating to Burying Grounds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section fourteen of chapter fifteen of the

- 2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding to said section
- 3 the following: 'Any city or town without giving bond there-
- 4 for may be appointed by the probate court testamentary
- 5 trustee for the purpose of holding forever in accordance
- 6 with the provisions of this section and the terms of the
- 7 devise, any fund devised for the purposes aforesaid.'

SECT. 2. The provisions of the foregoing amendment

- 2 shall apply to wills which have been probated since Jan-
- 3 uary 1st, 1892.
