STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED

AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to prevent the destruction of smelts in the harbors, coves and inlets in the town of Bluehill.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from

- 2 taking any smelts within one-half mile of the entrance of
- 3 any harbor, cove or inlet in the town of Bluehill, in the
- 4 County of Hancock, by means of purse or drag seines, or
- 5 by weirs.
 - Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate the provisions of this
- 2 act, shall, on conviction of the same before any municipal
- 3 court or trial justice of said County of Hancock, be
- 4 punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars, nor more

- 5 than twenty dollars, or imprisonment in the county jail
- 6 for a term not less than ten days, and imprisoned in said
- 7 jail for same time for non-payment of said fine.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
