STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF. OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit the setting of Lobster Traps within certain limits.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

All persons are hereby prohibited from setting any lob-

- 2 ster trap or traps within three hundred feet of the mouth
- 3 or outer end of the leaders of any fish weir, under a pen-
- 4 alty of five dollars for each offence, to be recovered on
- 5 complaint before any court of competent jurisdiction in
- 6 the county where the offence is committed, one-half to the
- 7 use of the complainant and one-half to the use of said
- 8 county.
