IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT additional to Chapter 389 of the Private and Special Laws of 1850; entitled "An Act to incorporate the city of Calais."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The fire department of the city while going

- 2 to and at fires shall have the right of way in the streets
- 3 of the city and it shall be the duty of all persons in the
- 4 streets when an alarm of fire is given to give way to said
- 5 department.

The engineers shall have control of all streets adjacent

- 7 to fires while in progress and may direct the use of the
- 8 same as may be for the best interests of life and property.

- 9 The above provision may be regulated by ordinance of 10 city council.
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
