
## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to Paupers not having any legal settlement within the State.

Resolved, That the Board of State Assessors are hereby

- 2 directed to cause an investigation to be made of the
- 3 number of paupers in the several towns and cities of the
- 4 State not having any legal settlement within the State and
- 5 the amounts such towns and cities annually expend for the
- 6 care of such paupers by sending to the overseers of the
- 7 poor of each town and city proper blanks of inquiry
- 8 relating to the same. They shall then report their findings.
- 9 to the next legislature.
