### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to legalize the doings of the town of Hermon.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The action of the town of Hermon in the

- 2 county of Penobscot at its annual town meeting held
- 3 March 14th, A. D. 1892, whereby it voted to raise six
- 4 hundred dollars for a permanent fund and fifty dollars
- 5 with which to build a tramp house under an article in the
- 6 warrant to raise money for the support and maintenance
- 7 of schools, of the poor, roads and bridges and to defray
- 8 all other necessary town charges is hereby legalized and

- 9 made valid. And the assessment of all taxes for the pur-
- 10 poses named in said vote shall be legalized.
  - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
