## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT for the protection of Trout in Alder Stream in the town of Corinna, in the County of Penobscot.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. No person shall catch, kill or destroy any
- 2 trout in Alder Stream in the town of Corinna, in the
- 3 county of Penobscot for a term of four years.
  - SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions
- 2 of this act shall pay a sum of five dollars, and one dollar
- 3 for every fish so taken to be recovered on complaint before
- 4 any trial justice in Penobscot county, one half to the com-
- 5 plainant and one-half to the county.
  - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
