STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT for the protection of trout in Eagle Lake in the town of Eden, in the county of Hancock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from

- 2 fishing for or taking any trout from Eagle lake in the
- 3 town of Eden in the County of Hancock, from the first day
- 4 of October in each year to the first day of May following
- 5 for a period of four years.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions

- 2 of this act shall be punished by a fine of five dollars for
- 3 the offence, and a further penalty of one dollar for each
- 4 trout so taken, to be recovered on complaint before any
- 5 trial justice in said county, one-half to the complainant
- 6 and one-half to the said County of Hancock.
